

2020 PRESIDENTIAL PRIMARY ELECTION TUESDAY, MARCH 3, 2020

The 2020 Presidential Primary Election is being conducted by mail. Eligible voters will receive their ballot in the mail.

- The Democratic Party does not require voters to affiliate with the party to participate in its primary election.
- The Republican Party requires voters to affiliate with the party to participate in its primary election.

To request a ballot or if you have not received your ballot by February 18th, please contact the County Clerk's Office at 435-676-1163, 435-676-1100 or 435-676-1120.

Please be aware that on Election Day there will be **NO POLLING PLACE** in your precinct.

Return your voted ballot by mail. Ballots must be **postmarked** by the day before the election (by **March 2, 2020**).

OR

You may drop off your ballot in person at the County Clerk's Office, Monday - Friday 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. through election day, Tuesday, March 3, 2020. On **Election Day** the Clerk's Office will be open from **7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.**

In-Person Voting will be available at the Garfield County Courthouse, 55 South Main Street, Panguitch, Tuesday, February 25th through Friday, February 28th, Monday, March 2nd from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. and Election Day (March 3, 2020) from 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.

A logic and accuracy test of the voting equipment will be conducted on Tuesday, February 18th at 11:00 a.m. in the County Clerk's Office.
