

# **2020 PRIMARY ELECTION**

## **TUESDAY, JUNE 30 2020**

**The 2020 Primary Election is being conducted by mail.** For this election, Garfield County will only have a Republican Contest.

- The Republican Party requires voters to affiliate with the party to participate in its primary election.

To request a ballot or if you have not received your ballot by June 16<sup>th</sup>, please contact the County Clerk's Office at 435-676-1163, 435-676-1100 or 435-676-1120.

Please be aware that on Election Day there will be **NO POLLING PLACE** in your precinct.

Return your voted ballot by mail. Ballots must be **postmarked** by Election Day (**June 30, 2020**).

**OR**

You may drop off your ballot in person at the County Clerk's Office, Monday - Friday 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. through election day, Tuesday, June 30, 2020. On **Election Day** the Clerk's Office will be open from **9:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.**

An individual with a disability who is not able to vote a manual ballot by mail may obtain information on voting in an accessible manner by contacting the County Clerk at (435) 676-1120.

A logic and accuracy test of the voting equipment will be conducted on Thursday, June 11th at 11:00 a.m. in the County Clerk's Office.
