



CODES IN EFFECT AS OF JANUARY 1, 2019

[H.B. 310, Construction Code Amendments](#), was signed into law by Governor Gary Herbert on March 24, 2016; this will go into effect July 1, 2016. Plans not previously accepted and fees paid for plan review to Salt Lake City Building Services, will be required to be designed & reviewed under the new codes.
